ANNEXURE-I

Specification

Scraping of old G.S. sheets, cemented and wooden surfaces; application of primer over the prepared surfaces and painting over the primed surfaces with two or more coats, including all necessary scaffolding. The work shall be carried out as per the instructions of the Engineer-in-Charge. (Materials will be supplied by Bose Institute.)

Terms & Condition:

1. The period of completion shall be 30 days from the third day after receipt of the work order from Bose Institute.
2. The bidder shall take all necessary safety measures during execution of the work.
3. All scaffolding required for execution of the work shall be within the scope of the bidder.
4. The bill shall be submitted after completion of the work.
5. Water and electricity, as required for execution of the work, may be provided free of cost by the Institute, subject to availability at source. The contractor shall make his own arrangements for distribution. However, no claim shall be entertained for non-supply of water and electricity by the Institute.
6. Space for storage of materials may be provided by the Institute; however, the security of materials and machinery shall remain the sole responsibility of the contractor.
7. Rubbish, debris, etc., arising out of dismantling of worn-out plaster, walls, etc., shall be removed by the contractor from the work site from time to time, as per the directions of the Engineer-in-Charge.
8. The contractor shall comply with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act and other relevant rules and regulations.
9. Work during holidays and/or beyond office hours shall be undertaken only with prior approval of the Competent Authority. A list of personnel to be engaged, mentioning their names and addresses, must be submitted in advance.
10. The contractor shall remain liable for any incidental charges arising due to natural calamities, accidents, or other unforeseen events.
11. Incomplete tenders are liable to rejection.
12. The item rates once quoted shall remain firm and fixed. No price escalation shall be entertained, even for work executed during any extended period, if applicable.
13. Tenders received after the scheduled date and time shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

14. The prices quoted shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes, including GST.

15. The tender/offer shall clearly and precisely quote the net unit rates both in words and figures. In case of any discrepancy between the amount written in words and figures, the amount written in words shall prevail.
